WHFF conference in Buenos Aires, Argentina

In the days before the conference, there was a successful classifiers workshop, an extensive youth program and farm visits.

The conference theme was 'Imaginemos el Futuro' – 'Lets Imagine the Future'. The themes included Genomics, What defines a Useful Cow, Production Efficiency and What is the Future for Dairy Businesses. The range of speakers and subjects was extensive. 498 delegates, of whom 223 were international delegates, joined the conference from 31 member countries.

After the conference were the Argentinian Expo Lechera and Dairy Expo 2016 Show. The Dairy Expo 2016 show was judged by Horacio Barberis, who judged the Champion of Dairy Expo 2016 to be SAN SATURIO SHEILA CHELIOS from La Sorianita II Fernando Martínez e Hijos.
