#### Terms of Reference for a Task Force on Inclusivity of more Production Data

#### 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Task Force is to enable WHFF to be more proactive and initiate discussion with ICAR regarding the inclusion of production and sensor data, and a mechanism of labelling the data as certified or non-certified data

#### 2. Task Force Focus

The Task Force will focus its efforts on the following issues:

- To improve labelling of data certified or non-certified
- Hold a survey amongst the WHFF membership
- Review data from robots and sensors
- Consult with ICAR regarding standardization of data that is input into INTERBULL.

## 3. Composition of the Task Force

The Task Force should consist of 3 Council members

#### 4. Procedure

- The Task Force will meet via an online platform to decide upon a plan of action.
- The Task Force will meet with ICAR to discuss.

## 5. Time Schedule

- Task Force members appointed and first meeting by 30 December 2021
- Plan of action to Council in February 2022
- Meet with ICAR at 2022 ICAR Conference May 2022
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Report to Council in autumn 2022
- Communications to WHFF membership where appropriate
- Presentation of results to General Assembly in 2023

# 6. Budget

If required, a budget could be requested from Council: Travel expenses to be carried by the respective Task Force member organizations where these are WHFF members. In other cases, a travel budget may be requested from Council.

## 7. Final Result

The Task Force will present the following information:

- Conclusions of discussions and meetings
- Survey of WHFF opinions and actions on the labelling of the source of Production Data
- Present to WHFF Council a suggested course of action regarding the inclusion of production and senor data
