FRIS.ITAL.I WHFF membership

Email sent out to all Council on 2/8/23

Before the General Assembly in France you need to decide whether you can admit FRIS.ITAL.I to membership of WHFF, and by extension to EHRC. If you agree they can become members, they need to have the opportunity to attend the WHFF Conference in November, 2023 in France and give a presentation explaining their herd book, breeding goals, aspirations and explain how they will follow the aims of WHFF.

I have now received the breeding specifications from FRIS.ITAL.I and have attached them. There are two documents, both in English.

Please can you read and consider these documents, and send me your comments. I may have to call a zoom meeting in September to discuss.

Martino has commented as can be seen in the email thread below.

In the document the FRISITALI_WHFF Member Application Form, there are an overestimation of members and animals due to a final verification of the ministry, for the 2023 FRISITALI has as official proxies of 67 herds and 27.405 heads of Holstein.

Take in mind that Agriculture ministry do not funds this association because of they have lower than 33% of Italian Holstein population under control and in their herd book.

Dear Suzanne, Martino and All,

I don't think there is a need that all board members are going to read the enclosed documents.

For me the main question is: if they are recognized as an official Herd Book or not... Since FRISITALI is a European Herd Book, they have to fullfill the demands of the EU-Regulation 2016-1012.

If they have received official Herd Book Recognition, by the Italian Authority (the responsible authority of the EU-member state); in my opinion they can become a member of both EHRC and WHFF.

If they have not received official Herd Book Recognition I don't see why we should accept them as a new member.
